He presented a proposal prepared by the Trail Youth Development Centre Society which would operate the facility. He advised that the youth centre would be operated as a separate society from the Church. The Society will be seeking funding from a variety of sources to operate the centre and requested Council's support.

Members of Council requested that the Society coordinate their plans with others in the community that are seeking to establish a youth centre as well.
