- 2. Please note that filling out the Owl Camp Scholarship Form DOES NOT GUARANTEE A SCHOLARSHIP OR PLACE AT CAMP.
- 3. No payment should be offered with the Owl Camp Scholarship Application Form.
- 4. If you have been awarded a scholarship we will let you know by June 5<sup>th</sup>
- 5. If you are awarded a scholarship, you will be mailed (or emailed) camp paperwork after June 5th, including essential registration forms that must be filled out by a parent or guardian. Included in this packet will be an invoice for payment. **Registration and Payments must be returned by June 19**<sup>th.</sup>
- 6. If you are awarded a scholarship, you must make your payment immediately in order to reserve your spot. If no payment is received by June 19<sup>th</sup>, we will likely give your spot away to another child.
- 7. If you do not receive a scholarship, please consider a work trade to help supplement your child's costs for camp. We have 2 work trade opportunities:
  - i. VAN DRIVER
     Full trade for camp
     Requires parent to drive the van from Bayer Farm to Camp each morning and afternoon for one full session.
  - ii. CAMP ASSISTANTPartial to full trade availableRequires parent to volunteer for at least 3 full days at camp for one session.
