The School's Objective

Goaltending is far more than just stopping pucks. This program will teach and drill all the **physical skills** related to modern goaltending. In addition, **mental skills** will be taught along with off-ice conditioning and many other elements to make each student a better Goaltender.

On and Off Ice Program

The Holiday clinic includes a variety of teaching techniques to improve a Goaltender's performance. Ice sessions are conducted in small groups, utilizing intense movement-oriented drills. Classroom discussions on the technical game, off-ice conditioning, and mental toughness are a ______ critical part

Equipment

All goalies must supply their own equipment. If needed, the clinic staff will provide assistance getting their equipment on to any young Goaltenders.

Ages and Structures

All ice work is done in groups of 3 or 4, with emphasis on what each individual student needs to work on. **Enrollment is strictly limited to 16 Goaltenders.** Applications are accepted on a first-come, first-serve, basis with accompanying payment.
