**CONTENT:** This workshop will provide beginning therapists with a broad understanding of couples and family dynamics and will focus on key elements that all practitioners will experience in working with couples and families. - 3. Learn specific strategies for working with couples and families to facilitate a positive outcome.



**Presenter: Bernard J. Baca, Ph.D., LCSW,** specializes exclusively in Imago Relationship Couples therapy. He has conducted national workshops on couples therapy, clinical treatment of sex offenders, and object relations theory and technique. Dr. Baca completed a doctorate in clinical psychology from the Union Institute and two Master's degrees in clinical psychology and social work from Central Michigan University and University of Wisconsin-Madison respectively. Dr. Baca has integrated object relations developmental theory into his practice with couples. He has published articles in books on envy in couples and on spirituality in couples therapy. He is a

member of the editorial board of the *Journal of Imago Relationship Therapy*. Dr. Baca has been in private practice for 25 years in both Indiana and Santa Fe, New Mexico. He is a certified Couples Imago Therapist and Couples Imago Workshop Presenter.
