

A weekend adventure into what it means to be a teenage girl!

Dear Parents;

Your daughter is being invited to participate in an exciting new program here being offered to rural communities surrounding Humboldt taking place at St. Peter's College in Muenster.

Just Girls is a group mentoring program designed to teach girls, grades 7 and 8, the importance of physical fitness, healthy eating and the skills to help build friendships and combat bullying. We want to give each girl a boost of self esteem and self confidence as she enters the sometimes tricky world of a teenager.

The weekend consists of a variety of sessions that include physical activities, games, guest presenters, as well as time for discussion and inspiration from the group and role models from around the community. Saturday runs from 10am to 4 pm, with lunch and a snack provided. Sunday runs from 1–5 pm (snack included). Participants are asked to attend both days.

An afterschool version of this program was run in 2012 in Humboldt and we are excited to offer it in a condensed form with more guests and new activities that will give the girls new experiences and a renewed confidence to be proud of who they are.
