Each year the SW Graduate School of Banking Foundation offers bankers who are members of the Arkansas Bankers Association a \$1,500.00 scholarship to the **SW Graduate School of Banking** at Southern Methodist University in Dallas, Texas. The scholarship – called the “SWGSB Millennium Scholarship” – is applied toward the first-year (new students) tuition for the School. In addition, the scholarship may be awarded the second and third year as long as the scholarship recipient remains in the top 10% of the class. “It is our way of giving back to the banking community that has so generously supported the SWGSB Foundation for five decades,” said S. Scott MacDonald, Ph.D., president and CEO of the SWGSB Foundation.

Those wishing to apply for the scholarship should submit their scholarship application to the Arkansas Bankers Association, which will make the final selection. The scholarship must be used for the 2015 Session of the SW Graduate School of Banking, which will be held May 25 – June 5, 2015.
