

# Things to See and Do in Lake Wanaka

WorldMark Wanaka is located in the heart of the Southern Lakes region of New Zealand. This alpine wonderland, in the southwest of the South Island, is the gateway to the World Heritage Area of Mount Aspiring National Park. The third-largest park in New Zealand is one of the most spectacular pristine wilderness areas anywhere in the world, stretching from the dense rainforests of Fiordland, across braided river valleys and alpine meadows to the heavily glaciated Southern Alps. The pinnacle of the park is Mt Aspiring (Tititea is the Maori name), rising elegantly from its flanking glaciers to 3027m, a peak much loved by local and international climbers, and photographers.

For those who love winter sports Lake Wanaka, with the largest skiable terrain in Australasia, can match anything in the world. But there's a lot more to this area than just winter sports. Extreme sports lovers and adventure seekers have the opportunity to go canyoneering, eco-rafting, kayaking, helibiking, mountaineering, bungy jumping, jet boating or rock climbing. Warmer weather provides a myriad of slower paced attractions including golf, sailing, picnicing, hiking, mountain biking or horse trekking in golden hills and valleys, four-wheel driving on high country farms and wine tasting at local vineyards. There are plenty of water activities at the lakes or just relax and soak up the summer sunshine.

The region's gallery and craft workshop trail would take days to do justice, yet a few hours can happily be spent watching jewellery makers at work, taking an artist-hosted studio tour or eyeing up New Zealand paintings and sculptures on show in some fabulous galleries. In late March the arts come together with the Wanaka Autumn Arts Festival, and the Festival of Colour. Family fun can be had at numerous locations. such as the Wanaka Transport and Toy Museum which has one of the largest private collections in the southern hemisphere. With over 400 vehicles, 12 aircrafts, 20,000 toys and thousands of miscellaneous items, this collection must be seen to be believed!

Stuart Landsborough's Puzzling World is a unique attraction with a theme of puzzles, puzzling and puzzlingly eccentric. A place for adults and children, great in any weather and perfect on a wet day too. The New Zealand Fighter Pilots Museum has an amazing collection of airworthy WWII fighters including a Mustang and Hurricane. The Museum store also stocks Lord of the Rings and Narnia collectibles. The area has also been used as a movie location for many familiar scenes from the silver screen such as The Water Horse, 10,000 BC, The Lord of the Rings, The Lion the Witch and the Wardrobe, Vertical Limit and Prince Caspian. If you are a film buff there are plenty of hot spots from the Lord of the Rings Trilogy you can visit by 4-wheel drive, horseback, jetboat or by walking. Take a drive to Glenorchy where you're sure to recognize some of the vistas from commercials.

# **Driving Directions**

# From Queenstown Airport

Head southwest on Sir Henry Wigley Drive toward Lucas Place.
Turn right at Lucas Place and right at Kawarau Road.
Turn right at Frankton Ladies Mile Hwy, drive for 5.8 km.
Continue on Lake Hayes Arrow Junction Hwy for 5.3 km.
Continue on Gibbston Hwy and make a sharp left at Crown Range Road.
Turn left to stay on Crown Range Road and drive for 16.8 km.
Continue on Cardrona Valley Road for 24.9 km.
Continue on McDougall St. and turn left at Ardmore St.
Continue on Wanaka Mount Aspiring Roadd.
The entrance to the hotel is clearly marked on the right.
