## **Philmont Training Center Masters**



To earn this knot, you must first attend a training course at the Philmont Training Center. Then you must go back to the Philmont Training Center to take an additional course AND recruit 3 other scouts to go with you AND you must go back home and TEACH a BSA course (usually the course you took at Philmont). The course can be taught at the District, Council, Area or Regional level.

If you go back to the Philmont Training Center for a third time, and meet other requirements, you can earn a device to be worn on the knot.



# Doctorate Commissioner Science Award



The Doctorate Commissioner Science Award is award to a Commissioner upon completion of a standardized program leading to the completion of a thesis or project and the award of the Doctorate of Commissioner Science from a College of Commissioner Science.

The College of Commissioner Science program is designed to have a commissioner learn, through a series of training classes, followed by work experiences to ensure a quality program throughout Scouting. This training will take a number of years to complete. The commissioner finalizes his/her training with an approved thesis or project for the benefit of the Scouting program. This assists both new commissioners as they learn, and seasoned commissioners as they train others.

## **BEING A REGISTERED SCOUT**

Registering as an Adult Leader is the first step to becoming a Scout leader. Registration is accomplished by completing a BSA Adult Registration Form and submitting it to your Unit COR (Chartered Organizational Representative). (District Level positions submit to the District Chairman). Forms are reviewed and routed to the Trapper Trails Council for final processing. Once you are registered you will receive a wallet size registration card with your name and official registration number. With this registration number you will be able to take and receive credit for all the MyScouting online training courses. You will also receive the Scouting Magazine.

You will need to register for each Scout leadership position you hold. This is accomplished by completing a new registration form for each additional position. You will receive a wallet size registration card for each position you are registered. Your registration number will be the same for each position you are registered. During Annual Re-Chartering you will be re-registered for your Scouting positions. Units Re-Charter in Oct-Nov each year and Districts Re-Charter in Feb-Mar each year. Any questions on your registration status please contact the Trapper Trails Council, Registration Office.

## **TRAINING CORNER**

Training for Scout leaders in the Weber View District comes in three forms: On-line, Classroom, and Outdoors. On-line training can be found on MyScouting.org. This site contains several required and optional self paced courses. As a registered Scout leader you can log on to the desired course and after completion of the course receive a certificate of completion. Classroom courses are primarily Leader Specific Training for your Scout position(s). These courses are offered by each District throughout the year. On the Trapper Trails Web site under Training there is a Training calendar. Each course is listed by date and sponsoring District, including any specifics required. Outdoor training included: Outdoor Leader Skills, Wood Badge, Powder Horn and several other courses. Each one is listed at the Trapper Trails Web site in the left hand side by course. Please make yourself familiar with the required and optional courses available to you. Pass the word to all your Scouter friends.

## **WOOD BADGE CORNER**

Wood Badge is an **advanced training** course for Scout leaders at all levels and experiences. Attending Wood Badge is voluntary and encouraged. Within the Trapper Trails Council we currently have **8 courses** conducted by highly trained and experienced Scouters. Wood Badge is held at several of our organized Scout camps and selected venues that bring the Wood Badge experience to all that attend. ## **DUTCH OVEN CORNER**

### **Breakfast Cornbread Dutch Oven Recipe**

**Ingredients:** ¼ C sugar, 1 tsp cinnamon, ½ tsp ground ginger, ¼ tsp salt, 1/4 tsp nutmeg, powdered milk for 4 cups, ½ C cornmeal, ½ C raisins, 1 TBS oil, 2 eggs, and ½ C pancake syrup.

**Instructions:** In a zip-loc bag, combine sugar, cinnamon, ginger, salt, and nutmeg. Warm 4 cups water in a pot, and pour in powdered milk and heat to steaming. Pour in cornmeal and reduce heat to simmering. Stir until thick, about 10 minutes or so. Remove from heat. Beat eggs and oil in a cup and stir into cornmeal. Stir in sugar mixture, raisins and syrup. Pour into Well-oiled Dutch Oven. Cook for about 40 minutes at about 350 degrees. Coals should covering the lid and about half that many under the oven. If a toothpick stuck in the center comes out clean, it is ready. This makes about 8 servings.

## **SCOUTMASTERS MINUTE**

### **Back it Up**

**This Minute is meant for Boy Scouts. Decide for yourself if it is appropriate for your younger scouts or not. Required: \$10 bill, Eagle patch or Life patch**

**Script:**

**You'll need a \$10 or \$20 bill - or even larger if you want to make a big impression :-)**

**Hold up the bill for all to see or pass it around the circle.**

**Ask, "What is this?"**

**Ask, "What is it worth?"**

**Ask why the bill is worth so much.**

**The bill is really just a piece of paper. It has no value. But, it has been created and certified by the U.S. Government to be 'worth' \$10.00 and can be exchanged for \$10 worth of food or other stuff. It is Backed Up by the strength of our government. Without that power and trust Backing It Up, the bill would be worthless.**

**Hold up the Eagle or Life patch.**

**Look at this patch. It's just a piece of fabric, not worth anything. But, it's valuable because we know it represents years of learning, leading, and serving. It is Backed Up by the efforts and commitment made by the young man that wears it.**

**When you receive your own patch like this, you will know that the patch itself is not that important. How you Back It Up is the important part.**
