
RELEASE AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK

I agree to bear all expenses incurred should an injury/accident occur. I represent that I am in sound medical condition and have no physical or medical impairment which would endanger myself or others. I further agree to wear an ANSI or Snell Certified helmet while riding on the tour. I will observe/obey all bike tour requirements, as well as West Virginia and Virginia traffic laws and regulations. I understand if I leave the route, I am no longer on the bike tour. I also give permission for the use of my name and/or likeness in any newspaper, broadcast, telecast or other accounts of this event. Wherefore, as evidenced by my signature below, I waive, release, discharge for myself, my heirs, executors and administrative/legal representatives any and all rights and/or claims which I have, may have or may thereafter accrue to me against the sponsors and promoters or their agents, officers and employees for any and all claims which may be sustained by me.
