Calendar of Events

October -Ms. Orand will discuss the sixteen OBOB titles. Students start reading the books. Books are available in the Library Media Center (LMC), Salem Public Library, or online for purchase. Students may also listen to unabridged audio recordings or have the books read aloud to them.

November-Team Sign-Ups: All students must attend a mandatory meeting explaining the program and permission forms are given to each participant. Teams consist of four students from any 3rd-5th grade classes. Each team designates a Captain and a Spokesperson.

December-Parent permission forms must be signed and returned no later than Dec. 12, 2014 to the LMC. No team photos are taken till all team permission forms are returned. January-February OBOB teams compete during recess or lunch (depending on your lunch time) from 12:30-1:00 in Rm. 120 on days to be announced in Jan. until we have a winning team. Parents are ALWAYS welcome to attend.

The OBOB School Championship will be held on Fri., Feb. 27th at 2:15 pm in the East Family Room, followed by an Ice Cream Sundae Party in the LMC for all OBOB participants.

March: Myers 1st place team will compete in the OBOB Region II Tournament Sat., March 7th, 2015 at Lincoln Elementary School, 1041 N. Boones Ferry, Woodburn, OR. If your team were to qualify, transportation must be provided by team parents.



The **Oregon Battle of the Books (OBOB)** is a state-wide voluntary reading and comprehension program. The goals are to encourage and recognize students who enjoy reading, broaden reading interests, increase reading comprehension and promote academic excellence.

Myers students participating in OBOB need to be in 3rd-5th grades for this school year. Students will select their teammates totaling four students, one of which is the Spokesperson and another the Captain. The Spokesperson's responsibility is to answer the question after the team discusses the question. The Captain's responsibilities are to see the team reads the books; has their team attend the mandatory meeting as well as see that team members participate in all the team's Battles.

This permission form must be signed by the student and parent/guardian and returned to Ms. Orand no later than Dec. 12th 2014. After your child's team has returned their permission forms, then a team picture will be taken to be posted in the Library Media Center.



Each Battle will consist of sixteen questions. Questions will alternate between teams. A coin toss will determine which team goes first. Teams will have 15 seconds to discuss the question. and only the team's Spokesperson will give the answer. Only the first answer given by the Spokesperson will be accepted for scoring.

If the first team doesn't answer correctly, then the other team will be given an additional 15 seconds to give the correct answer.

All questions will be in two formats:

In Which Book questions will be read first.

Three points will be given for the correct title and two points for the correct author.

Content questions: 5 points will be given for the correct answer. Partial scores will be given for only two part questions. Designated two-part questions will be scored with three pts. for the first correct answer given and 2 pts. for the second correct part of the question.

Every team will have a chance to compete at least twice.
