2014 will take place between 21st and 28th July, bringing together a range of events and activities in which we hope all of you will get involved.

Councillor Julian German will launch the week online so watch out for his film which will be shared on the 21st, followed by a week of activities including a fish and chip supper with Heudh yn Hav, a Yeth an Werin, pub sessions and church services. One highlight will be a performance of GogMagog, which includes some Cornish, in Perranporth on Friday 25th July following an afternoon of Cornish 'gems' in Perranporth. Saturday 26th sees a language fair on Falmouth Moor – a chance to join in with some Cornish language activities, music and dance!

Gwariva rag prevya hag arbrevi (Kanaseth Planet Kernow) a wra vysytha leow a vri hes ha hes Kernow dres hav 2014 gans, orth y golon, hwedhla gwariek a yll troghya hag omvyska pubonan. Yma kesragdres gans Gogmagog, yw proviys gans AGE (Arghas Gwari-dall Ertach) usi ow mires orth plenow an gwari yn Kernow. MAGA yw esel kessedhek dyghyta ragdres Plen an Gwari hag y re kussul orth an ragdres war dhevnydh a'n taves Kernewek.

Golden Tree Productions have produced a new play that includes parts entirely in Cornish. Gogmagog is their contemporary reworking of the ancient Cornish creation myth, which reveals a timeless story of conflict, survivors and asylum-seeking.

An experimental, experiential amphitheatre (the Planet Kernow Embassy) will tour iconic locations across Cornwall during the summer of 2014 with epic, immersive and participative theatrical storytelling at its heart. Gogmagog also has an HLF (Heritage Lottery Fund) funded companion project looking at Cornwall's playing places. MAGA is represented on the steering committee of the Plen an Gwari project, providing advice on the inclusion of the Cornish language. (<http://www.magakernow.org.uk/default.aspx?page=309>).

MAGA has been advising cultural groups on how incorporating Cornish into their activities can add value to all of their projects. Since April, demand for our services has grown. While we would like to support all cultural activities in Cornwall, our ability to do so is limited by the funding available.

Therefore, if you are considering a new project then bear in mind how using Cornish can help you and talk to us at the earliest opportunity so that the Cornish language is a meaningful contribution to your project and not an afterthought and can be built into the project budget or funding applications.

An Benneglos a with gool nebes sens Kernewek seulabrys, ha lemmyn der aga humyas kuv ni a wra aga gwitha yn Kernewek, yn kolon an eglos yn Kernow. An kensa a vydh Gool Sen Samson dy'Lun an 28ves mis Gortheren dhe 1 p.m., Oferen gewsys yn Kasel Sen Maria; an nessa a vydh Gool Sen German dy'Mergher an 1a mis Hedra dhe 5.30 p.m., Oferen solem kenys gans Keur an Benneglos. The Bishop's Group for Services in Cornish and Truro Cathedral are beginning a new and exciting venture in the coming months.

For the first time the Eucharist will be celebrated in Cornish in the Cathedral. The Cathedral keep the feasts of some Cornish saints already, and now by their kind permission we will celebrate them in Cornish, in the heart of the church in Cornwall. The first will be the Feast of St Samson on Monday 28th July at 1 pm, a said Eucharist in St Mary's Aisle; and second will be the Feast of St German on Wednesday 1st October at 5.30 pm, a solemn Eucharist sung by the Cathedral Choir. The sung setting will be in Latin, and the spoken words in Cornish: so there will be not a word of English, neither said nor sung.

In the past services in Cornish were held in the Cathedral, but have not been so for some years, and it's very good that they are to begin again. It's another small step in the growth of our language and culture; so, come and support our language, our identity and our heritage on those two days, and show that our language is very much alive and very important to us.

The service book will be in both Cornish and English – therefore, whether you speak Cornish or not, there is no excuse for you!
