**SEPSIS MANAGEMENT IN PEDIATRICS WORKSHOP**

**LEARNING OBJECTIVES**

To enhance the knowledge and practical guidelines in the management of sepsis in children, included the understanding sepsis pathophysiology in children, the International standard for pediatrics sepsis & Surviving Sepsis Campaign as well as the Early Goals Directed Therapy for pediatric sepsis implementations. After completing the workshop, registrants are expected to understand the difference between hemodynamics in children and adult, and the capability to manage hemodynamic in pediatric sepsis, to choose appropriate early antibiotics in pediatric sepsis, diagnosis and manage the coagulation in children with sepsis and giving the protective ventilation strategy in children with sepsis.
