- New supplies issued: Each nurse and SHA will have a "Received Stamp." This is to be used to date stamp incoming time sensitive health information or parent communication (e.g. MD orders, Parent Authorization to Exchange Health Information, Medication Authorization). Date stamp time sensitive forms stamped before attaching to the student HOA record.
- Nurses will receive a "Get a Grip" zip lock bag with a pair of hemostats and an instruction card to be kept with the Epi-pen[©] trainer. Hemostats are for SHS personnel use. Schools or families may purchase hemostats if needed for individual student or school staff use.

MESD SHAs performing delegations that involve needles will be issued a pair of hemostats.

8. Immunization updates

Senate Bill 895 is a new law about school immunizations for 2015-2016. Key changes are:

- Religious exemptions (now referred to as non-medical) signed prior to March 1, 2014 are no longer valid. Patents will be required to turn in documentation of immunization or complete the new process for a nonmedical exemption prior to Exclusion Day in February 2016.
- Schools and children's facilities (preschools, Head Starts and certified child care programs) will be required to have their immunization and exemption rates available at their main offices, on their websites, and for parents on paper or electronic format.
