Applicant must be receiving their diploma and be entering his/her freshman undergraduate year in the year following the scholarship award to be eligible to apply. Application packages must be postmarked no later than the last day of March in the scholarship award year and sent to the Meridian High School Guidance Office.

Announcement of winner(s) is expected to be made in May at the Senior Award Night. MESPA does not prepare written evaluations of either successful or unsuccessful candidates.
