1.0 GENERAL

1.1 Introduction

Naval Surface Warfare Center, Indian Head Division (NSWC/IHD) historically has supported engineering, logistic, training, and maintenance management developments for weapon systems and ammunition strategies introduced to the Navy and Department of Defense (DoD) inventories. Technical support and analysis of introductory systems, evaluation of impacts related to proposed modifications and assessment of related operational concepts have been simulated to ensure success upon fleet introduction. Investigation of environmental technology, logistics, packing, handling, storage and transportation, along with evaluation of related test and diagnostic equipment have been accomplished to ensure compatibility with operational environments. Modernization of the war fighter's munitions requirements is and continues to be a major readiness issue.

1.2 Scope

The contractor shall furnish personnel, services, capabilities, materials, equipment, and facilities required to complete the defined tasks below. Tasks will encompass those efforts necessary to support engineering, integration, installation, testing, logistics, training, and maintenance management of Navy and related DoD munitions and weapon systems.

2.0 REQUIREMENTS

2.1 Systems Engineering Support

To properly assess business processes and impacts to newly introduced or modified weapon systems, the contractor shall develop and provide system engineering tools and processes that support the Navy's decision making process. Services provided will span the entire life cycle of weapon systems introduced to the Navy's and DoD inventories. To satisfy mission needs, alternatives shall be developed and identified to meet cost, risk, schedule and readiness objectives. Capabilities and limitations shall be addressed along with human engineering issues and environmental concerns. In those cases where a weapon system has been introduced to the operational environment, technical support shall be provided to assist fleet maintainers and operators. This support shall provide managers with easy access, timely, accurate data, as required. Specific tasking shall include the following:

The contractor shall provide detailed engineering evaluation that identifies material movement equipment required to modernize and enhance existing capabilities to support mobilization. The contractor shall evaluate current capabilities and identify equipment and facilities that ensure designated installations and locations to include desert environments can meet assigned mission requirements. The contractor shall evaluate latest state-of-the-art robotics and conveyer systems as well as other types of material movement equipment. Additional facilities required to enclose equipment shall also be identified and documented. Contractor shall be required to identify operational software programs required to support introduction of all new equipment. Any software recommended must be compatible with and not interfere or modify existing government software programs such as Automated Identification Technology (AIT) and Logistics Modernization Program (LMP). Engineering Assessment must consider the introduction of new initiatives such as Strategic Configured Loads (SCL) and Unit Configured Loads (UCL) that will dramatically impact out-loading. All recommendations must be fully documented and supportable. Contractor shall

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provide necessary simulation/modeling techniques that will substantiate estimated cost and time savings achieved by utilizing new equipment. Support involves working with various government agencies to determine the most efficient and effective approach. Contractor shall seek commonality and standardization when recommending new equipment to include test equipment and systems to accommodate lower maintenance and sustainment costs.

2.2 Integration, Installation, and Testing Support

2.2.1 Equipment Integration and Installation

The contractor shall assist the Government to integrate and install developed software and equipment at various government sites and installations. These tasks include the fabrication, assembly, integration and installation of material movement equipment, including power, interconnecting cabling, and wiring. The contractor shall assist the Government with site planning and preparation to support equipment and system installations. Support personnel to provide on-call, on-site, product support for all software and equipment. The contractor shall provide assistance with upgrading and maintaining the products.

2.2.2 Test and Evaluation

The contractor shall assist the Government with the design of test methodologies and the performance of those tests to evaluate software and equipment capability as compared to documented criteria and objectives. The contractor shall develop and assist in the conduct of System Operation and Verification Testing (SOVT) plans to measure effectiveness. The SOVT planning and implementation shall address all specification requirements of the software or equipment being developed. It shall include the standards, checklists, validation materials, procedures, technical measures of performance, and tasks necessary to conduct product assurance, quality assurance, reliability, and maintainability. This effort shall include systems integration and testing, site integration, test simulation and emulation, and test documentation.

2.2.3 Verification / Validation

The contractor shall assist the Government with the verification and validation of developed software, equipment and systems. Verification shall include evaluation of software and equipment design documentation, operation, and maintenance documentation, test plans and procedures. Validation tasks shall include validation of performance, associated documentation, safety features, and the reliability/maintainability of the software or equipment. The validation process shall test the system as whole as well as the individual equipment and components.

2.3 Integrated Logistics Support

To provide more affordable logistics support for material systems the DoD is focusing on total ownership throughout the life cycle. Achieving affordable support depends upon effective acquisition logistics management and planning. The contractor shall develop and provide logistics support for weapons systems being developed by DoD and those already in operational service. Contractor shall provide program management and planning support within the Ammunition field to include maintenance, ammunition peculiar equipment and demilitarization. Contractor shall ensure supportability requirements are identified and that a balanced integration of logistics support is considered in the systems engineering process. Problem reporting and resolution support shall be provided for those systems, which are currently operational. Specific tasking shall include the following:

- 2.3.1 Investigate improvements and upgrades to DoD ammunition supply, inventory and procurement systems. Conduct analyses of shipboard and non-shipboard configuration data through audit and installation tracking and develop reports on configuration status accounting information including systemic problems and problem trends.
- 2.3.2 Provide analysis and recommendations regarding asset tracking and Inventory Management of operational weapon systems in NAVRES and DoD inventory. Provide on site logistics management to Navy and Army command personnel.

2.4 Training

The contractor shall provide support to the Government in examining and assessing present and future needs for development, maintenance and refurbishment of weapons trainers. Support shall include operator and maintainer

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computer-based-training and, in some cases, technical documentation development for aircraft and ship subsystems. Operator and maintainer interactive courseware shall be developed as required to support new weapon system introduction, technical ammunition training and existing systems/equipment or modifications. Specific tasking shall include the following:
