- 1. Title of research proposal
- 2. Summary (200 words)
- 3. Keywords (up to 5)
- 4. Research aims and objectives (up to 5) (What are the aims and objectives of your proposed research and why is it important?)
- 5. Research questions
- 6. Proposed research methodologies (From what sources will your information be obtained? How will you obtain this information and why have you selected this approach?)
- 7. Literature review (The literature review needs to be well-structured, critical and analytical. The literature review should demonstrate how the potential candidate has identified a gap in the literature pertinent to the research topic.
- 8. Proposed completion plan (including monthly plan and major milestones)
- 9. Main references in the research field (References must be properly presented in text and also in this section. Applicants may choose to use Harvard, Chicago or APA style. These referencing styles can be accessed on websites such as http://www.chicagomanualofstyle.org/tools_citationguide.html).
