

UNTOUCHABLE UNDERGRADUATE SCHOLARSHIP

SPONSORED BY THE DALLAS FORT WORTH ALUMNI ASSOCIATION

The purpose of this scholarship is to recognize an undergraduate brother for his hard work and dedication to Omega Delta Phi, himself, and his community. The award will be in the amount of \$1,000 to be paid in two \$500 disbursements in August 22nd for the Fall Semester and January 23rd for Spring Semester. The decision will be announced at the 2014 National Leadership Institute in Salt Lake City, Utah. Scholarship recipient does not need to be present.

Selection Criteria

The award will be decided by the National Director of Academics and a member of the Dallas Fort Worth Alumni Association based on the following criteria.

- 1. Grade Point Average (G.P.A) (Applicants with under a 3.0 G.PA. will not be considered. Also, the committee may within its discretion weigh certain G.P.A.s higher or lower based on the difficulty of major and/or credit hours)
- 2. Resume (Professional and Fraternal)
- 3. Personal Statement Addressing Reason for Applying
- 4. Letter of Recommendation from Entity President (If applicant is President, from Executive Board Member)
- 5. Community Service Hours (Applicants with under 20 community service hours will not be considered)

Requirements

Each candidate needs to obtain the signature of the chapter/colony internal vice president (verifying active status, GPA, standing), and service chair (verifying service hours).

The complete application must be **RECEIVED** no later than Friday, June 30, 2014 at 11:59 PM (PST). All incomplete, incorrect, or late applications will not be considered. In addition, **previous scholarship recipients are ineligible**.
