- Reason for your financial need and application for this educational scholarship
- Your personal and academic achievements with specific examples
- Your academic and career plans with specific goals
- Your past and current involvement, as well as future plans, towards making a difference in your community
- 6. A one-page short essay about Tzu Chi, based on the information you've gathered from websites, publications, news articles, etc. Please explain what you have learned about Tzu Chi that inspires you in any way. Express your thoughts openly and honestly.
