Eligibility Requirements:

- ✓ All students who wish to borrow Direct Loan funds must have a completed 2014-15 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) on file with Temple University.
- ✓ Non-matriculated students who are enrolled in courses required by the State of Pennsylvania for elementary or secondary teacher certification or recertification are eligible for Federal Direct Loan funding and are required to be enrolled at least half time.
- ✓ To qualify for Federal Direct Loan funding, a Non-Matriculated student must be enrolled in either the 6 or 12 week summer session. Students enrolled in the 4 week summer session do not qualify for federal funding.
- ✓ *Optional courses or certification programs that are not required by the state for elementary or secondary teacher certification that a student elects to take for professional recognition or advancement do not qualify.*
- ✓ New loan borrowers must complete the Master Promissory Note (MPN) and Entrance Loan Counseling online at www.studentloans.gov. You will need the PIN number used to file the FAFSA to complete this information.
- ✓ A full time student may borrow a maximum of \$5,500 in subsidized funding with up to \$7,000 unsubsidized funding per year.

Student Certification: I confirm that I am not currently certified (or am required to be recertified) to teach elementary or secondary education, that the courses I intend to enroll for the Summer 2015 are required by the State of Pennsylvania for elementary or secondary certification or recertification and they will be taken during a 6 or 12 week summer session.
