Updating your Will or Living Trust with a Codicil

If you already have a Will or Living Trust, and wish to make a bequest to Northeast Animal Shelter, this can be done using a "Codicil." A Codicil need not change the terms of your current Will or Living Trust; it can simply add a new instruction.

When writing a Codicil, there are a few simple rules:

- Don't try to change or add anything to your current Will by crossing out or writing in new instructions, as any handwritten changes will not be valid.
- A Codicil should be used for relatively minor changes.
- You will need to sign and date the document and have it witnessed by two people just like your Will.
- Keep the Codicil with, but not attached to, your current Will, in a safe place.
- Send a copy of the Will and Codicil to your Executor or other trusted friend, with a note indicating where the original is held.
- Tell any charities named in your Will and Codicil about your bequest.
