Camp Hours

Children 5-15 years old are grouped according to ages. Five year olds must be entering Kindergarten to attend camp.

Registration

Attendance

Please notify the camp secretary a week in advance to change the weeks that your child will attend. Credit will not be issued after a camp week has started. Fees will not be pro-rated for partial weeks attended. Make up days are not permitted, and *campers with balances in any YMCA program will not be allowed to register until balance is paid in full.*

Discounts

- Families with a **Family Facility Membership** to the YMCA will received one week of camp at a 50% off for one child.
- Families with more than one child attending camp will receive 10% discount for each additional sibling. *Siblings must attend same week to receive discount.*

What to bring

Campers should bring lunch, a water bottle, and sun screen. They should wear camp appropriate clothing and sneakers for safety purposes. **Campers will also need a bathing suit and towel for swimming each day.**

What not to bring.

Please refrain from bringing any electronic devices including video games, Ipods, mp3, cell phones, cameras, etc. Counselors will confiscate them and return at the end of the day. The YMCA is not responsible for any lost or stolen items. However, every day announcements will be made to inform campers of lost and found items.

Medication

Prescription medication in your child's name will be administered as prescribed. Medication must be stored in its original container with the amount and time of dosage clearly marked. Parents/Guardians must sign the medication log at the start of each camp week.

Health Policy

A health assessment form MUST be completed by the child's doctor before attending camp. A sick child is to stay at home. If a child arrives at camp not feeling well, the child may be sent home. The parent or emergency contact will be called. The child must be free of symptoms for 24 hours before returning to camp.

Field Trips

Campers will travel weekly to Graham Aquatics Center for a day at the pool. Other exciting field trips will be selected throughout the summer. Please refer to the parent handbook for field trip details.

Southern Branch YMCA Specialty Camps

All campers must bring a lunch, swim suit, towel, and any special items listed under each camp description. Specialty camps run from 9:00 AM– 4:00 PM. Before and after camp care is provided at no additional cost at the Southern Branch YMCA. **There is NO INITIAL \$30.00 registration fee** associated with specialty camps. The 50% discounted week for family memberships can not be used for specialty camps.

SPLASH Camp

Swim, Play, and Learn Aquatic Safety Habits

The YMCA SPLASH program is a national YMCA initiative that gives kids ages 6-12 an opportunity to learn water safety. The program is designed to prepare children for summer swimming programs as well as to help parents feel comfortable with their confidence and skills in and around water. As with all YMCA programs, the SPLASH program integrates character values into the instruction. The program covers five aquatic environments: public pools, backyard pools, boats, beaches, and water parks.
