ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Read this information carefully, your application form will be automatically rejected if you do not meet this criteria or you do not follow instructions as indicated.

- Dependent of MEA member or MEA-Retired member in good standing.
- Graduate of a Michigan public high school or private high school that has an MEA bargaining unit.
- Will attend or is currently an undergraduate student of a Michigan public community/junior college, four-year degree-granting institution, or vocational training institution that grants a degree, certification or license. Those attending the following private institutions ONLY are also eligible: Baker College-Flint/Owosso; University of Detroit–Mercy; Davenport University-Eastern Region Campus; Adrian College; Finlandia University; Albion College; and Kendall College of Art and Design of Ferris State University. (The aforementioned private institutions are existing local MEA affiliates.)
- Note: Children of MEA officers, fund trustees, and MEA staff are not eligible. (A child of an MEA, MESSA or MEA-FS staff person is eligible if the other parent is an MEA member in good standing.)

APPLICATION RESULTS

- Applicants can expect to be notified of the outcome of their application by mid-April.
- The amount and number of scholarships offered shall be determined each year by the MEA Scholarship Fund Trustees. The scholarship is renewable not more than four times in a five-year period, at a lower monetary amount than the initial award, subject to satisfactory academic progress.

SELECTION CRITERIA

Priority is given on the basis of:

Academic achievement.

Extra-curricular activities.

School and community service.

Students from lower income households.

In addition:

DO NOT STAPLE

- Scholarship determination will be made strictly on the merit of the applicant's performance against the above criteria. The selection and award of scholarships is a nondiscriminatory process.
- MEA Scholarships will be awarded by the trustees of the MEA Scholarship Fund. This body is composed of MEA members and persons appointed from the general public. The fund is financed through the voluntary contributions of the members, staff and friends of the Michigan Education Association.

METHOD OF APPLICATION

- Applicants must complete ALL sections of the application form. Do not staple any of the materials or put materials in any type of folder or portfolio, as it will be discarded. In addition, do not include any unnecessary documents with the form, such as photographs, news clippings or IRS/income tax information, as they will be disregarded.
- By submitting this application, the applicant is attesting to the accuracy of the information given and to his/her compliance with the criteria of the scholarship.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION/SIGNATURE CHECKLIST

- □ **High school applicant:** Official high school transcript showing cumulative GPA, including 1st semester senior year, and any higher education course transcripts including dual enrollment
- □ **High school or undergrad applicants:** Two letters of recommendation that address applicant's qualifications in meeting the selection criteria (may not be a family member or a school principal/designee or counselor/college advisor if writing statement on page 3)
- □ Undergrad applicant or returning recipient: Copy of high school transcript
- □ **Returning recipient**: One letter of recommendation
- □ All applicants: Copy of SAT and/or ACT score documentation (if not included on high school transcript) only best score
- Undergrad applicant or returning recipient: Current official college transcript
- □ All applicants: Personal statement (see page 4)
- □ All applicants: Personal resumé (one-sheet limit is strictly adhered to)
- □ All applicants: Principal/designee or counselor/college advisor statement and his/her signature (see page 4)
