## 4. PROOF OF INSURANCE

- a. At a minimum, the Policy shall provide coverage of not less than \$500,000 per person and \$1,000,000 per aggregate. The Policy shall list the Town of Fort Myers Beach as an additional Insured and shall provide that coverage shall not be canceled or materially altered except after 30 days written notice has been received by the Town. The operator or applicant must also provide a copy of the declaration page of the operator's insurance policy with a listing of all insured watercraft by serial number.
- b. Proof of the continued coverage under the insurance policy shall be provided upon the Town Manager's request, given with reasonable notice at any time, that the PWVL is valid and outstanding. Any failure to provide such proof shall render the PWVL null and void and of no further use and effect. The holder's subsequent application for a new PWVL shall be subject to the regulations for a new business and shall lose the nonconforming status afforded under Section 27-55 of this Ordinance.

- 6. Also, with this application, each applicant needs to submit a current copy of a Lee County Occupational License and an Occupancy Permit (when applicable).
- 7. Each operator/applicant shall submit an evacuation plan with this application. Each plan will describe how operator/applicant will evacuate and secure their business site upon one (1) hours' notice from the Town of evacuation.

# Rules and Regulations Operators and Vendors need to be aware of:

- 1. Shall not lease, hire or rent a personal watercraft to any person who is under 16 years of age.
- 2. Shall have and maintain a <u>telephone</u> and an operable <u>marine radio</u> at its land based operations office.
- 3. No person shall offer for rent, lease or bailment for consideration, a personal watercraft which is not registered in the name of the business and which does not have a valid <u>Florida</u> vessel registration number affixed thereon.
- 4. Each business shall have a <u>motorized chase vessel</u> with operational marine radio in good running condition that meets all U.S. Coast Guard safety requirements kept at the personal watercraft launching site during all hours of the business operation.
- 5. Personal watercraft should be moored in the water and <u>not blocking pedestrian traffic</u> on the beach.
- 6. In order-to adequately monitor the operation of the personal watercraft, <u>one employee per five personal watercraft</u> actually rented, must be located so as to observe the operation of the vessel by the party renting the personal watercraft.
- 7. Fuel <u>tanks may not be stored on the beach</u>, but may be stored at the business location provided all applicable Federal, State and Local fire, safety and environmental regulations are met.

- 8. Fueling of personal watercraft on the beach or in the water shall require <u>a spill-proof nozzle</u> or other acceptable device designed for prevention of fuel overflow.
- 9. No billboard or free standing signs advertising the rental of personal watercraft are permitted on the beach.
- 10. The personal watercraft vendor must instruct each personal watercraft operator to:
  - a) To travel at idle speed until past said markers;
  - b) To maintain a distance of not less than 500 feet from the shoreline while operating the personal watercraft;
  - c) To travel at idle speed when returning to the shore; and
  - d) To not travel within environmentally sensitive areas, such as Estero Bay except with an eco-tour operator or guide associated with a business with a valid permit.
  - \*\* Each owner/vendor has the responsibility to obtain and obey the regulation In Ordinance No. 96-27; 96-26 Ft. Myers Beach Vessel Control Ordinance; and Ft. Myers Beach Land Development Code Section 34-3151- Water Oriented Rental Establishments.
