BAPTISMS

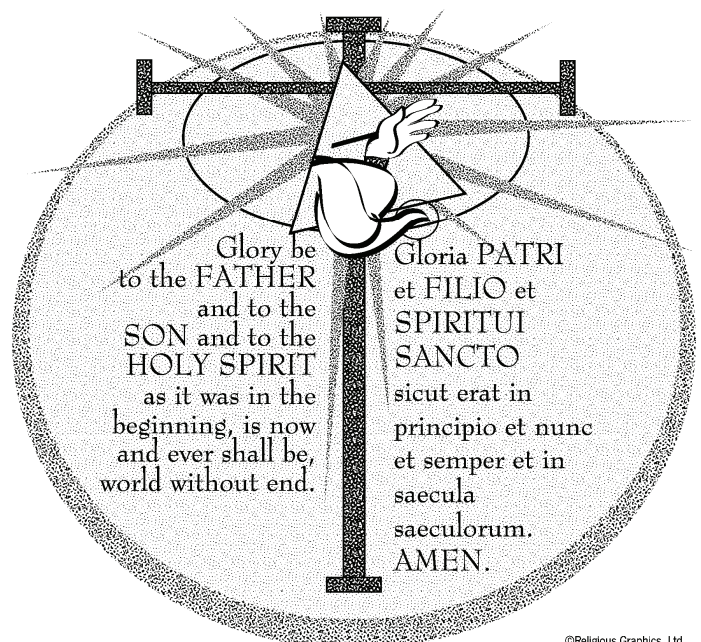
