May God's blessings be yours this week.

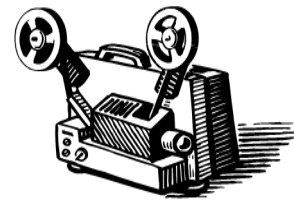

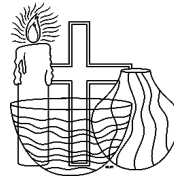
