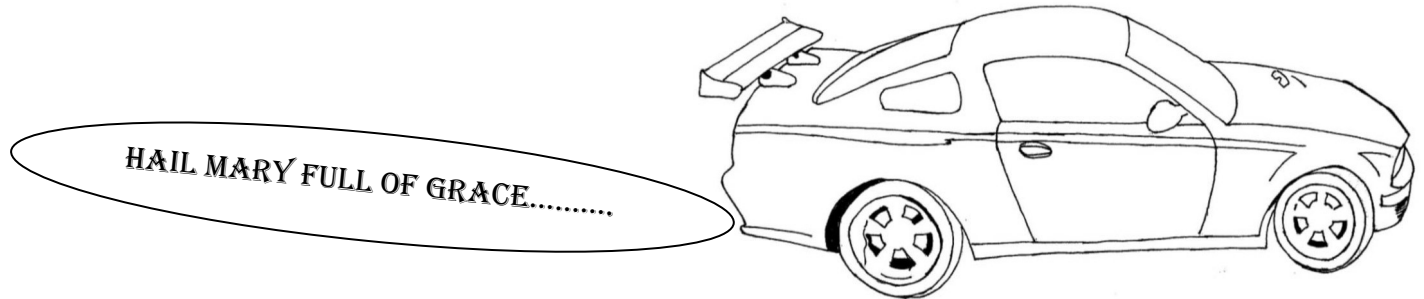

Many of us will have childhood memories of praying the Rosary, as children it felt long and tedious as one Hail Mary followed another. The messing, the giggling and the stern look of disapproval! While the Rosary is prayed less often in homes today, I am not sure if anything has replaced it? We are less inclined to pray together especially within the home. On school visits to the sacramental classes, I have been very heartened to hear of children tell me that there is a particular prayer, or prayers that they pray at home with their parents.

I appreciate that it is not easy for parents to encourage the practice of praying together as family. At preparation meetings with parents, I often make the suggestion of praying in the car on the way to school. At that stage all are washed and dressed, fed and watered! Turn off the radio and pray one Our Father, a Hail Mary, or a prayer to their Guardian Angel, praying for a happy and safe day. It can work, it takes a little persistence to form the habit of prayer, and the car is a good place to start!

For the rest of us, we don't always have to pray in the church or in our homes. I love the space offered in a walk by the canal or out in the country. Rosary in hand, a decade prayed for family, for a friend or parishioner brings you into close communion with God.

When I pray the Joyful Mysteries, and think of the birth of the child Jesus, I bring to mind all expectant mothers and especially young couples who long to have the blessing of a baby and the anxiety they feel when it's not happening!! The fifth joyful mystery, the finding of the child Jesus, and I remember the disappeared and their families.

So the Rosary, long and tedious? Not so sure! It can be relaxing, restful, a mantra like prayer. Where we experience the peace and comforting closeness of God. "Unburden all your worries onto the Lord, since He is looking after you" (1 Peter 5:7)

Perhaps a full Rosary is a big ask, how about praying just a decade? October the month of the Rosary might be a great time to start!
