#### **Expansion News**

The library construction project is progressing well. When the additions to the building are completed in October, the library staff and services will move into the new section. Thereafter, the existing building will be completely renovated, and the project is expected to be finalized in the Spring of 2012, barring unforeseen delays. We appreciate the understanding and good humor of our patrons and the library staff, as the construction has created some challenging situations.

In July, we received notification that our grant application was approved by the Hartford Foundation for Public Giving. The Hartford Foundation grant will fund improvements in the Young Adult Room and common areas, including computers, furnishings, workstations, books and Radio Frequency Identification Technology, a new system that will bring a state-of-the-art approach to the way the library is able to track its collections. This is the largest contribution to the Expansion Fund that we have received, and it resulted in attainment of our \$1 million campaign goal. We are extremely grateful to the Hartford Foundation for this award.

Other capital campaign funds will be used to support enhancements to the building in technology, furniture, signage, electronic bulletin boards, self-check-out stations, programming and collection development. The fundraising effort, chaired by Mark Nolan, will continue through the completion of the project, in order to equip the library with these enhancements and to endow a fund to support future needs.

We are very grateful to all our donors who have made our campaign a success. If you have not already contributed, please consider a donation, which will enable us to incorporate features that will benefit our entire community.

#### Two National Grants Awarded to Avon Public Library for Civil War Commemoration



Tina Panik and Patrice Celli of the Avon Public Library have been awarded two grants from the American Library Association (ALA) and the National Endowment for the Humanities (NEH).

The first grant is "Let's Talk About It: Making Sense of the American Civil War." The project consists of a five-part series of reading and book discussions, which will be led by Dr. Matthew Warshauer, Professor of History at Central Connecticut State University.

The book series will take place January through May, 2012. Each program will focus on different perspectives of the Civil War through works of historical fiction, political speeches, diaries, memoirs, biographies, and short stories. The first three lectures will be held at the Avon Congregational Church on Rt. 44, and will take place at 7 pm on: January 11, 2012, February 8, 2012, March 7, 2012.

The second grant is a national traveling exhibit titled, "Lincoln: the Constitution and the Civil War." This exhibit will be installed in the newly renovated community room during Fall 2012. "The exhibit will identify three crisis: the secession of the Southern states, slavery, and wartime civil liberties, and explores how Lincoln sought to meet these political constitutional challenges."

Both of these grant-funded programs will serve as a continuation of the Avon Library's commemorative celebration of the 150h anniversary of the American Civil War, a collaborative community project that began in March 2010. The goal to provide a better understanding of the Civil War and promote discussion of the complex issues of this period in American history.


