SCHOOL PAYMENTS

Families who owe 'large' amounts to RPS (see recently mailed statements) are strongly encouraged to set up a regular weekly direct deposit payment plan through their bank, to the school official account, over summer, to clear all 2015 outstanding debts before school starts up again in 2016.

END OF YEAR

Our school year is quickly coming to a close, with the next couple of weeks looking quite busy with the winding up of another active school year.

Wednesday 9th December is Grade 6 Graduation at Eltham Community Centre and our grade 6s are certainly looking forward to the evening. Our parents organising committee do a fabulous job and I thank them for their wonderful support.

Most of our grade 6s will attend their year 7 Orientation Day Tuesday 7th December, with students next year attending Eltham High (14), St Helena Secondary College (4), Warrandyte High (4), Ivanhoe Grammar (2), Viewbank Secondary (1), Whitefriars College (1), Catholic Ladies College (3) and Mountain Creek State High QLD (1). We wish them all the very best.

END OF YEAR

Children will meet their 2016 teachers on Friday. Student Reports and their Learning Journals will also be sent home that day. The staff do a marvellous job arranging class groups for the following year and I thank them for their time and energy in what is a very complex procedure.

Our structure for 2016 will be eight grades: Preps, 1, 2 x 2/3, 3/4, 4/5, 2 x 5/6, with Art, PE and LOTE our three specialist areas and Carmel's Keyboards/Piano Program offering private music lessons. We have kept some grade level groups as a large group rather than say, have 3 or 4 grade 4 girls in each of the two classes. We also have across the school 16 more boys than girls in our total 2016 enrolment of 206.

This week also sees the 2016 teacher teams involved in detailed planning for next year. The planning ensures consistency across the classes and with our very successful numeracy zones operating again next year, the opportunity for children to work with a wide range of students and a variety of teachers.
