The seminar brings together high school juniors and seniors from Winchester, Virginia to Greenville, Tennessee for a weekend of fun and an opportunity to learn and practice leadership skills. Participants will have the opportunity to hear outstanding speakers, participate in team activities, practice leadership skills and grow personally by sharing ideas and experiences with peers throughout the district. Participation in the Rotary Four Way Test Speech Contest (RFWT Speech Contest) is encouraged but is optional.

#### Transportation to and from RYLA:

Transportation is to be provided by the sponsoring Rotary Clubs, as no student is permitted to drive himself/herself to the RYLA Seminar. Students participating in the RFWT Speech Contest may require special transportation arrangements. Rotary Club sponsors and parents shall communicate directly all transportation arrangements. Student will not be permitted to leave the seminar site while RYLA is in session. If there are special circumstances, the attendee's parents and sponsoring Rotary Club need to make arrangements and share with RYLA Coordinators. All RYLA chaperones and drivers are required to complete a Background Check Form (Separate File Attachment which may be obtained from sponsoring Rotary Club or RYLA Website).

Any **inclement weather** that occurs during the conference will be closely monitored. If it becomes necessary to cancel the seminar, parents and Sponsoring Clubs will be notified immediately. Travel arrangements or alternate plans for students will be made with parent permission. Chaperone and students will be appraised of seminar modifications or cancellation due to weather.

**Seminar Attire:** Students participating in the speech contest should wear professional attire otherwise dress throughout the seminar is nice casual (jeans permitted). Please bring tennis shoes for group/physical activities and warm outdoor clothing for outside activities. Be sure to bring a warm jacket or coat. The dinner on Friday evening is nice casual. Saturday evening is a little dressier. Guys should wear slacks and a dress shirt (jackets and ties optional) and ladies should wear a nice dress, jacket dress, or skirt and blouse. Remember your dancing shoes for both Friday and Saturday nights!

## **2015 Rotary Four Way Test Speech Contest**

Friday, December 4, 2015 | 10:30AM

The speech contest is one way Rotarians can support students who make healthy choices in the ethical issues that they face in everyday life as teens. Students are subjected to pressure from peers to engage in unhealthy, unwise and unethical behaviors and choices, and the speech contest enables Rotarians to reward teens who not only set healthy and ethical life goals for themselves but who also seek to influence their peers in positive ways.

The RFWT Speech Contest will be held on **Friday morning, December 4, 2015, just prior to the beginning of RYLA (Registration begins at 9:30 AM so special travel arrangements may need to be made). The Speech Contest will begin at 10:30 AM. The purpose of the speech contest is to help teens address ethical issues that they face and develop the skills and responses to inform friends and family and other students of the choices in ethical issues and to relate those to the Rotary Four Way Test. Students in District 7570 face the same temptations, the same pressures, and the same ethical and behavior choices, as those teens across the country.** 

Speech contestants (High School Juniors/Seniors) are asked to present a six-minute persuasive talk, directed toward their peers, to promote high ethical standards in daily life. Topics may include personal experiences and/or knowledge of ethical behavior, decision making, peer pressure, relationships, bullying, substance abuse prevention or other experiences as it relates to the Rotary Four Way Test of the things we think, say, or do. Further, each presenter should describe his/her ideas for reducing and/or eliminating negative and unethical behavior in teens. The speech will be judged for content and presentation.

Please note that the RFWT format herein replaces the Substance Abuse Prevention format used in previous years. The content should be focused, clear, and accurate, and should be delivered in a logical, organized, and persuasive manner. Articulation, body language, creativity, and effectiveness in engaging peers in the message of ethical choices and behavior relating to Rotary's Four Way Test will be important criteria in judging presentations.

#### **Rotary's Four Way Test**

First, Is it the truth? Second, Is it fair to all concerned? Third, Will it build goodwill and better friendships? Fourth, Will it be beneficial to all concerned?

Speech participants are encouraged to dress in a professional manner. We are not prescribing that students must go buy a suit or dress. Rather, we would like for the students to consider attire that is consistent with a presentation they would give if they were visiting business leaders at a local Rotary Club meeting.

On Friday morning, December 4, 2015, a panel of adult judges will select six finalists. The finalists will deliver their presentations at the first General Session of RYLA, beginning at 1:00 Friday afternoon. Students attending RYLA will vote to assist in the selection of the first, second, and third place winners. The three winners will receive prizes of \$700, \$500, and \$300 for first through third places. The second and third place winners will be invited by their sponsoring Rotary Club at a future date to deliver their presentation and receive their award check. The first place winner will deliver their presentation and receive their award check at the District 7570 Conference on Saturday, March 19, 2016, at The Homestead at Hot Springs, VA. **Questions about the RFWT Speech Contest may be directed to Whit Menefee, 540-476-0710 or wmenefee@yahoo.com**
