More Mouths to Feed

Even though Oasis is not completely ready to formally open its doors, we have been presented with instances that just couldn't wait. Three starved horses were brought in to Oasis from a large boarding facility in southern NJ. One horse - a small, senior Arabian gelding - has a hip injury so serious that he cannot run on all 4 legs, and a raging eye infection that destroyed the vision in his left eye. He was skin and bones. In pain and totally isolated from his former herd-mates (actually from all the farm's equines, for that matter), he was the epitome of a broken spirit. The transporters were concerned that the little horse would not be strong enough to travel to the Oasis farm and would need to be euthanized. However, little Lexus had the will to live and somehow knew he was leaving his dark environment. With all 3 herd-mates in tow, they made their way to Oasis. They have been reunited, and what a reunion it was! Everyone was in tears at seeing the joy these animals displayed being back together. They are being nursed back to health, and at ages 24 and 26, they will become permanent residents of Oasis.
