COMPLAINT

The Complainant, being duly sworn, makes complaint to the above-named Court and states that there is probable cause to believe that the Defendant committed the following offense(s). The complainant states that the following facts establish PROBABLE CAUSE:

Complainant, George Peltz, of the Minneapolis Police Department, has investigated the facts and circumstances of this offense and believes the following establishes probable cause:

Between the dates of December 1, 2013 and December 12, 2013, officers spoke to a witness who reported that the 19 Block Dip Set gang was storing illegal firearms and ammunition at a residence located at 3111 Girard Avenue N., Minneapolis, Hennepin County, Minnesota. The witness reported that a resident of 3111 Girard Avenue N., an adult female identified as **BRIDGET NATASHA TURNTINE**, the Defendant in this case, allowed gang members keep their firearms in the basement and other locations in the residence. The witness stated that illegal guns were possessed and deposited by gang members inside the residence. Officers received information that the 19 Block Dip Set gang was stockpiling guns and ammunition and were looking to retaliate over the death of their leader, Tyrone Washington, who was murdered in North Minneapolis on November 3, 2013. The 19 Block Dip Set gang is a violent street gang from North Minneapolis with a propensity to use violence and firearms in their ongoing wars with other street gangs in Minneapolis.

On December 12, 2013, officers conducted a high-risk entry and search of 3111 Girard Avenue N., pursuant to a search warrant. Inside the residence, officers located Defendant, numerous 19 Block Dig Set gang members, and three young children whose birth years are 2004, 2005, and 2013. Two of these children are Defendant's biological children. Defendant was acting as a caretaker for the third child at the time of the officers' entry. These children are identified as Victim A, Victim B, and Victim C. The children were located in the dining room along with numerous violent felon gang members. Officers then searched the residence and located seven guns, an extremely

large amount of ammunition for various types of weapons, and multiple extended firearm magazines. Three of the guns were located in drawers in the dining room where gang members and the victims were located. Each gun was loaded and in close proximity to the victims.

Officers also located three guns in the basement of the residence. Two guns were stuffed into a diaper box which was found below the stairwell. One gun was hidden in a rafter in the basement ceiling. Officers located the seventh gun in the pocket of a black and red jacket which was sitting on a bed in a bedroom adjacent to the dining room. The gun in the jacket was accessible to the two oldest victims. Officers recovered a large amount of cash and marijuana from the residence. Officers also discovered the drug-dealing of felony-level amounts of narcotics was occurring in the yard of the residence immediately before officers executed the search warrant. Officers arrested multiple defendants for possession of illegal guns and narcotics. Officers also arrested Defendant.

Defendant is in custody.
