





#### **INTEGRITY – Match behavior with values**

Demonstrate your positive personal values in all you do and say. Be sincere and real. Black black and white, no grey

#### FAILURE LEADS TO SUCCESS – Learn from mistakes

View failures as feedback that provides you with the information you need to learn, grow, and succeed.

Orange put an "orange twist" on failure

#### SPEAK WITH GOOD PURPOSE – Speak honestly and kindly

Think before you speak. Make sure your intention is positive and your words are sincere. **Purple** royalty: I speak with royal respect

#### THIS IS IT! – Make the most of every moment

Focus your attention on the present moment. Keep a positive attitude.

**Red** fired up about each moment

#### COMMITMENT – Make your dreams happen

Take positive action. Follow your vision without wavering.

Green green and growing, committed to my growth

#### **OWNERSHIP – Take responsibility for actions**

Be responsible for your thoughts, feelings, words, and actions. "Own" the choices you make and the results that follow.

Blue true blue—I own who I am and the choices I make

#### FLEXIBILITY – Be willing to do things differently

Recognize what's not working and be willing to change what you're doing to achieve your goal. Aqua fluid like water

#### BALANCE – Live your best life

Be mindful of self and others while focusing on what's meaningful and important in your life. Inner happiness and fulfillment come when your mind, body, and emotions are nurtured by the choices you make.

### THE 8 KEYS OF EXCELLENCE FOR SCHOOLS

What if you could create and sustain a culture of character?

What if your school atmosphere felt cohesive and focused?

In any group or society, shared principles lay the groundwork for acceptable behavior. People who are aware of their shared principles and agree to uphold them know what to expect from one another. They experience a higher level of trust, more teamwork, and ultimately, greater success. Researcher and educator Mary Driscoll proclaims, "One of the hallmarks of the learning community is a system of principles that are shared and commonly understood among the members in the organization."

When adopted by a school, the 8 Keys of Excellence do more than create a more manageable and productive school culture – they change lives. Becoming aware of principles and committing to them is both exciting and challenging, pushing us to improve and to have a positive impact on the world we live in. As we begin to "live" the 8 Keys, those we come in contact with are influenced by our behavior. Like dominoes, the process continues, each person affects the next – from the principal to the administrative staff to the teachers to the students – demonstrating the positive effects of living the 8 Keys of Excellence.

#### INTEGRATING THE 8 KEYS OF EXCELLENCE INTO YOUR SCHOOL'S CULTURE

The 8 Keys of Excellence are basic principles that are "lived" throughout your school—by your administrative staff, by your teachers, and by every student in every classroom—and even in the homes of your students.

How to implement the 8 Keys in your school:

- 1. Administrator shares the Keys with faculty and staff. Together develop a yearly plan. They commit to live the Keys to the best of their ability every day.
- 2. Teachers share the Keys with their students and together the class agrees to learn to live them every day.
- 3. Students share the Keys with their parents and other family members who commit themselves to infusing the Keys into their lives.

As the Keys are practiced, seen and mentioned they quickly become a natural and vital part of your school's culture of character.

#### Introducing the 8 Keys to Your Faculty and Staff

#### 1. Model

We get what we model. Select one Key a week and do your best to focus on what it looks and sounds like in your daily attitude and interactions. It's infectious.

#### 2. Introduce the 8 Keys at staff meetings

The first time you mention the 8 Keys of Excellence to your faculty and staff explain your vision about how the Keys can strengthen the culture of character. Hand out a list of the Keys with a

brief description of each. Using the "8 Keys Check List," each staff member examines the school and their classroom cultures. After looking at the results arrange the Keys in priority order. At subsequent meetings, cover one or two Keys at a time. Dialogue about what that Key looks and sounds like in the classroom. Following the introduction and discussion commit together to use and live the Key until the next staff meeting.

#### 3. Read and share

Staff members read a chapter each week from The Eight Keys of Excellence: Principles to Live By, and then share their thoughts about the Key of the week with colleagues.

#### 4. Display the 8 Keys

Post the Keys where faculty and staff see them every day (administrative offices, staff lunchroom, meeting room, or other common areas).

#### 5. Reinforce the Keys

- Begin each meeting by inviting your staff to share the ways they have been living the Keys.
- Observations on how others (perhaps some one in the news) have or have not been living the Keys can also be shared. Choose public figures—governor, mayor, athlete, musician and examine how they demonstrated or did not demonstrate the Keys.
- Choose a Key at each meeting. Staff members give a short presentation on the chosen Key at the next meeting, including a definition, a story that illustrates it, or an activity that teaches it. Another option: Everyone focuses on the chosen Key and then reports their observations of how it was lived or not lived (personally or by others) during the period between meetings.

#### 6. Check progress

Occasionally complete the assessment form (copy at the end of this section) to see how evident the 8 Keys are becoming. At the next meeting discuss areas that are working well and areas that need improvement. When everyone feels that awareness and "living" of the 8 Keys is continuing and growing, it's time to celebrate!

The best advocates for the Keys are the people who use them. Before you introduce the 8 Keys in your school, you may want to read what others have said about the 8 Keys over the years.
