## 2014 PALO VERDE FRESHMAN ACADEMY - ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF RULES AND GUIDELINES

Student and parent/guardian understand and agree to comply by signing.

**ACADEMY HOURS:** 8:00am - 12:00 pm, June 2 – June 13, 2014

**SCHEDULE:** Freshman Academy will meet every day from 8:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. Breakfast and lunch will be provided. Breakfast will be served from 7:30-8:00 a.m. and lunch will be served from 12:00-12:30 p.m.

**ILLNESS:** Should a student fall ill during the school day, we will contact home for parent/guardian to pick up the student. **There is no nurse on staff during summer school – any medications must be administered by parents prior to school or parent must bring and dispense medicine to the student.**

**DISCIPLINE PROCEDURES** “A zero tolerance policy” is enforced and discipline problems, (e.g. excessive absences, fighting, behavior, insubordination, use of illegal substances including tobacco, as well as other infractions listed in the “Student’s Rights and Responsibilities”), are grounds for immediate dismissal without earned course credit. For all other disciplinary issues: the 1<sup>st</sup> offense will result in 1 hour of custodial duties after academy. A 2<sup>nd</sup> offense will result in dismissal from without earned course credit. Students are to leave skateboards, cell phones, radios, CD players, beepers, and any other amusement or recreational items at home. Cell phones are permissible only during breaks and before and after school. **Visible cell phones during class time will be confiscated.** Reasonable and proper attire, including footwear must be worn at all times. The dress code will be enforced per Palo Verde High School and TUSD Rules and Regulations. Finally, **NO** food or drinks are allowed in the school buildings other than bottled water

**PARKING:** All student parking will be in the student parking lot on the south side of Palo Verde High School. Students are not to park in the Faculty/Staff parking lots. Unsafe driving or reckless endangerment to self or others can revoke the privilege of parking on campus.
