



RACKHAM DUAL/JOINT DEGREE PROGRAMS

Rackham Dual/Joint Degree programs are those programs officially sponsored by two departments, programs, or schools whose combined curricula have been reviewed and approved by the Graduate School's Executive Board and results in a reduction of hours towards each degree.

An individual is admitted to two separate programs that are inseparable. The individual is working toward two degrees that are dependent upon each other. Both degrees may require to be awarded at the same time, and the individual will receive two separate diplomas.

Form Instructions

1. Complete all personal information including name, ID number, contact information and the date you are completing the form.
2. Complete the name of each degree/certificate (i.e. M.S. in Math), the date you expect to receive (or have received) each degree/certificate and the minimum hours required for each degree/certificate.
3. List ALL courses (i.e. NRE 560) taken except courses that count only towards a doctorate degree (i.e. 990 & 995). "VI", "NFC" and undergrad courses - all courses that count towards one degree on one side, all courses that count towards the second degree on the other side.
4. Complete the total hours applied to above degree. Have the form signed by the department/graduate chairs or designate and submit to Rackham.
