Early Childhood Screening

Do you have a child between the ages of 3-5 years old? Early Childhood Screening checks your child's hearing, vision and development. The state of Minnesota now recommends that all children be screened before their 4th birthday. This screening is required before your child starts kindergarten in a public school.
