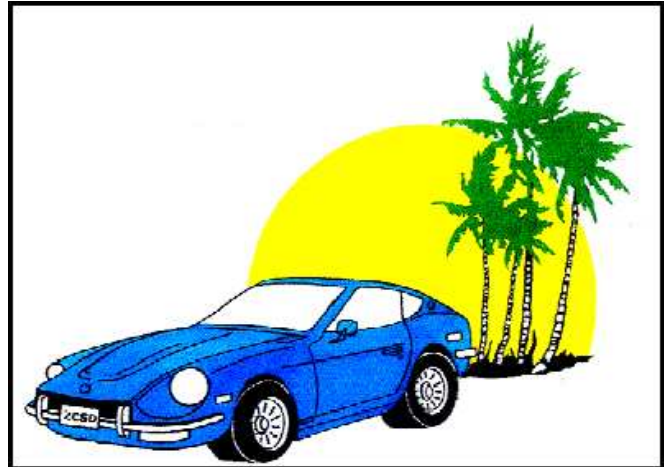

## MEETING HIGHLIGHTS

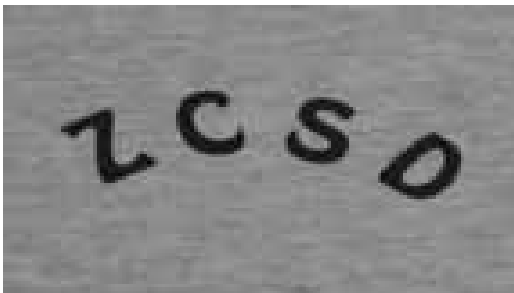

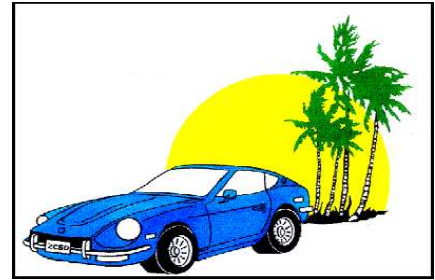
