The goal is to frame a transition plan to be presented to the Fellowship in the *2014 Conference Agenda Report (CAR)*. - ❖ **Traditions Book Project** – NAWS is still gathering ideas about what this book should. A session profile for use at fellowship workshops can be found at www.na.org/traditions. Input may be sent to worldboard@na.org or you may use the online form to submit workshop results. Sometime this month, NAWS will be initiating a Traditions Discussion Board.
- ❖ **“An Introduction to NA Meetings”** – This service pamphlet is still out for review and input from the fellowship until April 30th, 2013, to be edited & re-formatted so this piece may be presented in the *2014 Conference Agenda Report* to become a Fellowship-approved informational pamphlet.
