Notification of recipients – Recipients will be notified by May 9, 2015. Unfortunately, due to the large volume of applicants, only successful scholarship recipients will be notified.

Judging – Applicants will be judged on exemplary community service, demonstrated community and school leadership, academic achievement and economic need, in that order.

Residency requirement – Applicants must reside in a Township in Erie County. Borough and City residents will not be considered.

Application submission requirements – *Incomplete applications will not be considered*. Applicants **must** submit all of the required information. Use the check off list below to insure a complete application.

- A letter of recommendation from the guidance counselor written on high school stationery.
- Two additional letters of recommendation.
- A letter of acceptance from the college, university or school.
- A list or resume of school activities participated in by the applicant with offices held and honors received during high school years.
- A list or resume, with short descriptions, of the applicant's experiences in community service including church activities.
- An essay written by the applicant summarizing plans for education, future goals, and financial needs.
- A color picture of the applicant to be used for publicity purposes, which will not be returned
