CROWE, INDIVIDUALLY AND AS CO-TRUSTEES OF THE WILLIAM LLOYD CROWE REVOCABLE LIVING TRUST) WITHIN THE DESIGNATED BOUNDARIES OF THE CRITICAL (SOUTHERN CORKSCREW **REGIONAL** CREW **ECOSYSTEM** WATERSHED) PROJECT STYLED SOUTH FLORIDA **WATER** MANAGEMENT DISTRICT V. CAMILLE B. SNYDER, ET AL., FILED IN THE 20TH CIRCUIT COURT FOR LEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, CASE NO. 04-CA-1334; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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WHEREAS, Sections 373.083 (1) and 373.129, Florida Statutes, authorize the South Florida Water Management District to settle existing lawsuits,

WHEREAS, the Parties have been engaged in negotiations in an attempt to acquire the subject property without trial; and

WHEREAS, the Parties have been successful in presenting a proposed settlement to the Governing Board of the South Florida Water Management District; and,

WHEREAS, the terms of the proposed settlement are set forth on the attached document;

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BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE SOUTH FLORIDA WATER MANAGEMENT DISTRICT:

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To authorize a settlement agreement for \$80,500.00, plus \$19,965.00 for statutory attorney's fees and \$14,485.00 for experts fees and costs, for a condemnation action involving approximately 5 acres, (Tract No. 003-701 – William Lloyd Crowe and Pamela M. Crowe, individually and as Co-Trustees of the William Lloyd Crowe Revocable Living
