Arrival Procedures

Please arrive at WinSport's Markin MacPhail Centre no less than **30 minutes** prior to your lesson start time.

Park at the Players' Entrance on the east side of the building (#1 on meeting spot map).

Parking is also available across from the main entrance located on the north side of the building beside Canada's Sports Hall of Fame (#2 on meeting spot map).

Please note: the Players Entrance parking lot can become congested on evenings and weekends and may add time to your arrival.

Check-in Procedures

From the Players' Entrance: In the main lobby you will see a digital display board on your right indicating the time of the lesson, what arena it will take place on and which dressing room to use. Please be advised arena and dressing room assignments are subject to change weekly.

From the Plaza Entrance: Turn right upon entry and make your way down to the Event level via the stairs or elevator. There is a digital display board near the bottom of the elevator indicating the time of the lesson, what arena it will take place on and which dressing room to use.

On your first day of lessons, a check-in desk will be set up at the arena your lesson is scheduled to take place on and participants will need to check-in with our Skate & Hockey School staff. All subsequent lessons, participants will proceed directly to their assigned dressing room(s) and once ready for the lesson, make their way to the lesson meeting spot to meet the instructors and wait for the lesson to begin.

What to Bring

- Copy of you program confirmation email
- Completed and signed waiver form
- □ Previous Progress Card (if applicable)
- Hockey or figure skates
- CSA approved helmet is required, but face mask is only recommended
- Warm clothing in layers
- Winter gloves or mittens

Parent & Tot Skating – All parents participating in the lesson with their child must be confident skaters and have skates and a CSA approved hockey helmet. No street shoes or bike helmets allowed on the ice.

Youth Power Skating – All participants must wear full hockey/ringette gear including a hockey/ringette stick.

Skate & Helmet Rentals

Skate & helmet rental packages are available for all skating programs, except for Discover Figure Skating and Youth Power Skating at a cost of \$8/lesson. Skate and helmet rental packages must be pre-purchased by calling Guest Services at 403-247-5452.

Please Note: Parents, please respect the "Parent-free zones" located on all players' benches.

- Cancellations made greater than 5 days prior to the program start date will be refunded less a \$20.00 processing fee.
- Cancellations made between 5 days and 24 hours prior to the program start date will be credited to the purchaser's WinSport account.

TO: Calgary Olympic Development Association ("WinSport") and its directors, officers, employees, instructors, agents, representatives, independent contractors, subcontractors, volunteers, successors and assigns (all of whom are hereinafter referred to as the **"Releasees"**).

In this Release Agreement, the term "Skating Program" shall include learn to skate programs, ice skating lessons and camps, hockey skills camps, ringette skills camps, ice skating, ice skating drills, hockey drills, ringette drills, all activities involved in playing hockey and ringette and all other programing and activities connected with or related to the skating, hockey or ringette program.

ASSUMPTION OF RISKS

I am aware that participating in the Skating Program involves many risks, dangers and hazards including, but not limited to injury or death from: falling on the ice surface; unwanted contact with the puck/ring/ball or other equipment, including but not limited to hockey sticks, ringette sticks, skate blades, unsecured nets or net pegs, shooter tutor, Ice Resurfacer and arena glass; tripping in uneven sections of ice or cracks or ruts in the ice surface; collision with other participants, the arena boards or the net; exposure to cold conditions; tripping or falling; sudden stops or changes in direction; negligence on the part of other participants or users of the Facilities; the failure to act safely or within one's own ability; and NEGLIGENCE ON THE PART OF THE RELEASEES. I UNDERSTAND THAT NEGLIGENCE INCLUDES FAILURE ON THE PART OF THE RELEASEES TO TAKE REASONABLE STEPS TO SAFEGUARD OR PROTECT ME FROM THE RISKS, DANGERS AND HAZARDS REFERRED TO ABOVE.

I FREELY ACCEPT AND FULLY ASSUME ALL SUCH RISKS, DANGERS AND HAZARDS AND THE POSSIBILITY OF PERSONAL INJURY, DEATH, OR PROPERTY DAMAGE OR LOSS RESULTING THEREFROM.

RELEASE OF LIABILITY, WAIVER OF CLAIMS AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

In consideration of the Releasees accepting my application for participation in the Skating Program offered by WinSport at Canada Olympic Park in Calgary, Alberta and permitting my use of the arena, dressing rooms, dryland training facilities, restaurants, parking, access roads, parking lots and other facilities (hereinafter "the Facilities"), I hereby agree as follows:

1. TO WAIVE ANY AND ALL CLAIMS that I have or may in the future have against THE RELEASEES, and TO RELEASE THE RELEASEES from any and all liability for any loss, damage, expense or injury including death that I may suffer, or that my next of kin may suffer, resulting from either my use of or my presence at the Facilities or participation in the Skating Program, DUE TO ANY CAUSE WHATSOEVER, INCLUDING NEGLIGENCE, BREACH OF CONTRACT, OR BREACH OF ANY STATUTORY OR OTHER DUTY OF CARE, INCLUDING ANY DUTY OF CARE OWED UNDER ANY APPLICABLE OCCUPIERS' LIABILITY LEGISLATION ON THE PART OF THE RELEASEES. I UNDERSTAND THAT NEGLIGENCE INCLUDES FAILURE ON THE PART OF THE RELEASEES TO TAKE REASONABLE STEPS TO SAFEGUARD OR PROTECT ME FROM THE RISKS, DANGERS AND HAZARDS REFERRED TO ABOVE;

2. TO HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNIFY THE RELEASEES from any and all liability for any damage to property of or personal injury to any third party, resulting from my use of or presence at the Facilities or participation in the Skating Program.

3. This Release Agreement shall be effective and binding upon my heirs, next of kin, executors, administrators, assigns; and representatives, in the event of my death or incapacity;

4. This Release Agreement and any rights, duties and obligations as between the parties to this Release Agreement shall be governed by and interpreted solely in accordance with the laws of the Province of Alberta and no other jurisdiction;

5. Any litigation involving the parties to this Release Agreement shall be brought solely within the Province of Alberta, and shall be within the exclusive jurisdiction of the Courts of the Province of Alberta; and

6. In entering into this Release Agreement I am not relying upon any oral or written representations or statements made by the Releasees with respect to the safety of participating in the Skating Program other than what is set forth in this Agreement.

I HAVE READ AND UNDERSTAND THIS RELEASE AGREEMENT AND I AM AWARE THAT BY SIGNING THIS AGREEMENT I AM WAIVING CERTAIN LEGAL RIGHTS THAT I OR MY HEIRS, NEXT OF KIN, EXECUTORS, ADMINISTRATORS, ASSIGNS AND REPRESENTATIVES MAY HAVE AGAINST THE RELEASEES.
