WHAT SHOULD CAMPERS BRING EACH DAY?

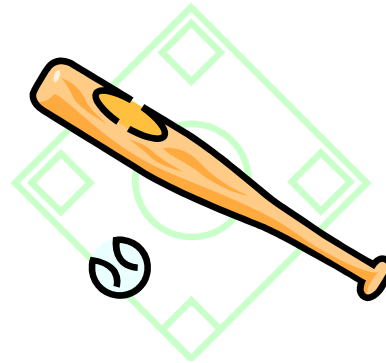
