- 1. Fully completed application form (attached)
- 2. Original long form birth certificate showing full details including parents' details.
- 3. Copy of current passport.
- 4. Proof of address in Scotland.
- 5. Fee £18.00 (Bank Draft or Postal Order only) per replacement certificate.
- 6. A self addressed <u>registered mail</u> envelope must be included for the safe return of your documents.

Applicants resident in England, Wales, Isle of Man and the Channel Islands must submit their application to the Embassy of Ireland in London.

Please note: all requests for a replacement Foreign Birth Registration Certificate are sent to the Department of Foreign Affairs & Trade in Dublin to be reissued. Once the Certificate has been reissued it will be returned to this Consulate and posted to the applicant in the envelope provided.
