California State University**

Sergio Aguilar-Gaxiola is Professor in the Department of Psychology at California State University, Fresno. Dr. Aguilar-Gaxiola is the on-site Principal Investigator of the Mexican American Prevalence and Services Survey (MAPSS), the largest mental health study conducted in the U.S. on Mexican Americans. He is a member of the National Advisory Mental Health Council (NAMHC), National Institute of Mental Health (NIMH). He holds several World Health Organization (WHO) advisory, board, and consulting positions; and is the Coordinator for Latin America and the Caribbean of the WHO World Mental Health (WMH) initiative. On June, 2004 he was elected as Chair Elect of the Board of Directors of the National Mental Health Association (NMHA). He is also a member of the Executive Board of Directors and is the Past Chair of the Prevention and Children's Mental Health Services of the National Mental Health Association (NMHA). He is also a member of the Board of Trustees of the American Society of Hispanic Psychiatry (ASHP) and a member of the California Policy Institutes on Health Statewide Advisory Committee. He is also the President of the Board of Directors of the Children Mental Health Foundation.
