**Miss Tohono O’odham Nation Titleholder’s
CODE OF CONDUCT**

I, _____, in accepting the position of Miss Tohono O’odham Nation 2011-2012 do understand the duties and responsibilities of this position. These duties and responsibilities include, but is not limited to attending all Committee approved scheduled appointments and appearances as an ambassador for the Tohono O’odham Nation.

I accept the following code to govern my conduct during my reign as Miss Tohono O’odham Nation and or Attendant.

1. I will conduct myself at all times in a manner that will not jeopardize the reputation of the Tohono O’odham Nation and the title of Miss Tohono O’odham Nation.
2. I will attend all meetings scheduled by the Miss Tohono O’odham Nation Committee (Committee) as directed by the Committee and provide verbal appearance reports at these meetings
3. If I am a student, I will report my grades to the Committee within two weeks of the end of each grading period. I will maintain at least a “C” grade in each of my classes. If I receive an “F” grade in any one of my classes, I will be placed on suspension from all appearances for an amount of time to be determined by the Committee.
4. If I am a student I will comply with all school rules. If I should violate any of these rules, I will report it to the Committee Chairperson or other Committee officer within 48 hours of its occurrence.
5. If I am employed, I will abide by all Personnel Policies applicable to my employment. Should I violate any of the Personnel Policies I will inform the Committee Chairperson or other Committee officer within 48 hours of the occurrence of the violation.
6. I will not consume or have possession of any alcoholic beverages, illegal drugs and/or inhalants.
7. Attendance at any places of entertainment such as dances, concerts, etc., must be approved by the Committee.
8. I will not attend any functions wearing my sash or crown or allow my name, photograph, or recordings of my voice to be used for any commercial purpose without the permission of the Committee.
9. I will respect and cooperate with the chaperone assigned to me by the Committee. I will stay within sight and voice distance of my chaperone at all times.
10. I will dress in traditional attire during all official engagements; this is in effect from the time I am picked up for official engagement to the time I return home.
11. Exceptions for travel attire may be made by the designated Chaperone depending on the distance of travel.

12. Sashes worn during my reign shall not be altered in any way such as markings or memorabilia that may affect the appearance of my attire. Items may be worn on the Sash only with the approval of the Committee.
13. I will respect the traditions of the Tohono O’odham Nation and all other cultures.
14. I will respect all people I come in contact with.
15. I will, during my reign, assist in recruiting contestants for the next Miss Tohono O’odham Nation Pageant.
16. I will not engage in a relationship or cohabitate intimately with any significant other.
17. I will not have had any children nor will I become pregnant during my reign.
18. I will continue to abide by the qualification requirements to enter into the Miss Tohono O’odham Nation Pageant.

I understand that any violation of the above may result in forfeiture of the title of Miss Tohono O’odham Nation and or Attendant. In the event of a violation, I understand that I will be notified of the alleged violations. Within ten (10) days of receiving notice I can request a hearing before the Miss Tohono O’odham Nation Committee or I can resign. The Miss Tohono O’odham Nation Committee will make the **final** decision of my standing as Miss Tohono O’odham Nation and/or Attendant. All decisions made by the MTON Committee are final.

If I choose to resign or I am removed from the title of Miss Tohono O’odham Nation, I will return the Miss Tohono O’odham Nation woven crown, trophies, sashes and any other awards received as a title holder within two weeks (14 days) after resignation or notification of removal from my title. This includes forfeiture of the cash award provided at the completion of my reign.

I have read and understand the Miss Tohono O’odham Nation Titleholder’s Code of Conduct. I hereby accept this code to govern my conduct during my reign as Miss Tohono O’odham Nation and or attendant.
