Why The Work Number?

The General Services Administration, National Payroll Branch, has contracted for an automated service - **The Work Number**[®] - that verifies your employment and income in a matter of minutes with a single phone call.

The Work Number[®] provides instant employment and income verification. This fast, secure service is used when applying for a mortgage or loan, for reference checking, leasing an apartment or any other instance where proof of employment or income is needed. You benefit from having control of the process – authorizing others access to your information.

What Kinds of Information Does The Work Number Provide?

You can give a potential employer or lender access to two levels of information about you

1. Employment Verification
2. Employment Verification and Income Verification.

If Someone Wants to Verify My Employment, What Do I Do?

Ask if the following information is sufficient

- First name, middle initial, and last name spelled out,
- Your employment status,
- Most recent start or termination date,
- Total time with your agency,
- Job title

If this information is sufficient, simply enter your social security number in the attachment below and give to the verifier.

What if Someone Needs Additional Information About My Salary and Income?

In addition to the basic information, you can authorize the system to give a verifier information about your

- Total salary,
- Gross earnings year-to-date,
- Overtime,
- Bonuses, and
- Gross earnings for the prior 2 years

To receive employment and income verification, the verifier will need a 6-digit code called a “Salary Key”. You can have a maximum of 3 “Salary Keys” at one time. Each code can be used only once, by one verifier. Complete the entire attachment and give to the verifier.

Follow These Easy Steps:

For Proof of Employment only:

- 1) Enter Social Security Number (SSN) in box below
- 2) Tear off section below and give to verifier

For Proof of Employment and Income:

- 1) Go to the Work Number at either
 - www.theworknumber.com/employee, or
 - Call 1-800-367-2884
- 2) Enter the following information
 - Your Agency Employer Code (See reverse side of flyer)
 - Your Social Security Number
 - Your PIN (consists of 4 digits of your birth year + last 4 digits of your SSN)
- 3) Select to obtain a Salary Key and then write down the Salary Key given to you
- 4) Tear off section below & give to verifier.

 - Your Agency Employer Code:
