Priority Passport - £2 for 12 months (£1 for children)
for residents who receive any of the following:

- Job Seeker's allowance (income based)
- Guaranteed Pension Credit (not Savings Credit)
- Income Support
- Housing benefit
- Council Tax benefit
- Employment & Support allowance (income related)
- Working Tax Credit with Child Tax Credit**
- Working Tax Credit which includes a disability element**
- Child Tax Credit only**

**Note: your Tax Credit award must be based on total annual income which entitles you to full NHS exemption. The qualifying amount for the 2010-11 tax year is £15,276. If you are reading this after 31 July 2012 please phone us for details.

Access Passport - £3 for 12 months (£1.50 for children)
For residents who receive any of the following:

- *Job Seeker's allowance (contribution-based)
- *National Insurance Credits (you must be "signing-on" at the Jobcentre as registered unemployed)
- Carer's allowance
- Incapacity Benefit (not Statutory Sick Pay)
- *Employment & Support Allowance (contribution based)
- *Industrial Injuries Benefit
- *Disability Living Allowance
- Severe Disablement Benefit
- *Attendance Allowance
- *Registered disabled or deaf or blind or partially sighted
- *Blue Badge Holder
- *Registered wheelchair user
- Full time student aged 16 or over
- Working Tax Credit with Child Tax Credit
(total annual income for 2010-11 tax year over £15,276)
- Working Tax Credit only (regardless of total annual income)

* note: these benefits do not include dependents

Passports are available for dependents (adult or child). Names and proof of dependency must be clearly shown - and in the case of children we may ask for child benefit proof or birth certificate if name is not clearly shown.

When you apply

If you apply in person

- Please make sure that you bring the necessary documents (see the chart)

If you apply by post

- please do not send cash
- make cheques or postal orders payable to Kirklees Council
- we will return all documents to you
- we accept photocopies of documents if these provide all the details we require
- we will send your passport to you within 10 working days

If you know somebody who would like this leaflet in a different language other than English, or in Braille or large print, please contact us and we will make appropriate arrangements.

The “+1” scheme

Do you know that if you receive either:

- * **the high or middle CARE component of Disability Living allowance, or**
- * **Attendance Allowance, or**
- * **you are registered blind**

you can join the “+1” scheme. You can then take someone with you, free of charge, to certain arts events, concerts and sporting activities. Please ask for more details - and don't forget to state on the application form that you wish to join the “+1” scheme.

How to apply: complete and sign the application form.

Show proof of entitlement (see the chart) If this doesn't show your address please also show proof that you live in Kirklees.

Provide a passport-sized photo.

If you want the extra free parking disc please show your vehicle registration document showing you or your spouse/partner as the registered keeper.

Pay the correct fee.

Please note: Letters showing benefit proof must be no more than 4 weeks old. If they are, please also show evidence that benefit is still paid into your bank account (ie. bank statement less than 4 weeks old). *For tax credits we accept current award letter.

Your Passport benefits include:

- One hour's additional extra free parking in certain short stay off-street car parks (registered vehicle owners) **Please check the car park you are using is covered by the scheme**
- 50% off swimming and up to 25% off sporting and leisure activities
- 50% off pest control and environmental services
- 25% off MOTs
- Dog neutering for only £15
- 10% off Library shop items over £5 (not including stamps)
- 10% off Tourist Information shop items over £5 (not including stamps)
- Discounts on Library loans such as CDs, DVDs and videos
- Concert discounts at Lawrence Batley Theatre and Town Halls
- Free entry to Castle Hill Tower
- Driving lessons
- High street shops/services **...and lots more.**

Priority Passport holders also receive:

- Discount off music school tuition in Kirklees Council schools

Terms and conditions:

The Kirklees Passport

- must always be shown to receive a discount
- can only be used by the cardholder and no one else
- is valid for 12 months or until the holder is no longer eligible
- remains the property of Kirklees Council and must be returned on demand
- will be invalid if defaced, or made illegible through damage

Kirklees Passport holders should note:

- It is an offence to use a Passport which does not belong to you or for which you are no longer eligible
- Please inform us if you change your address
- The additional free parking disc is only available to Kirklees Passport holders who are registered car owners and can show proof of this - you can only get one disc per card application
