(To endorse a Settlement Plan you must have been living in Manitoba as a permanent resident for at least one year.)

- e. I have not received or been promised payment or any other consideration for signing this Settlement Plan.
- f. I understand that the provision of any false statements or concealment of any material fact may result in, but not limited to, refusal to approve this or any future support, refusal to grant or withdrawal of the applicant's Certificate of Nomination, or any other enforcement action.
- g. I understand that the Government of Manitoba may contact me directly for any matter related to this application.
- h. I agree to the release to the applicant of this Settlement Plan - Part 2 and all supporting documents.
- i. The information provided by me is true, complete and accurate.
- j. I understand and am prepared to comply with all the commitments and obligations contained in this Settlement Plan, and I have asked for and received explanation for every point about which I may have been uncertain.
- k. I swear/affirm this commitment to be bona fide.
