

UM Pay is the official billing and payment system for actively-enrolled students at the University of Minnesota. Look for an e-mail notice in your University e-mail account when your online billing statement is available. Use the link provided to login to your UM Pay account with your University-assigned Internet ID (X. 500
user name) and password that ensures only you have access to your billing information online. Download and print copies of your bill or view your account history. Make payments from your checking or savings account or with a credit card (online option only). You may also set up an authorized payer, such as a
parent, to pay online on your behalf. You may opt to make payments by U.S. mail or in-person at a campus Bursar Office or drop box location. To do so, enclose your check or money order with a printed copy of your online billing statement. Always provide your name and student ID number with your payments.

## Secure access

Your University billing statements are only available online where you have private, secure access from anywhere, at anytime, on the Internet. Go online to set up account information for yourself or an authorized payer, e.g., a parent, spouse, or guardian. Paper bills will not be mailed.

## Charges

Tuition, fees, housing, meal plans, books, insurance, or related charges will be listed here.

Credits
Payments received, financial aid credits, and other credit adjustments will be listed here.

Your payment must arrive by the due date or you will be assessed a $\$ 30$ late payment
fee and hold will go on your record that prevents future registration and transcript/diploma releases. Payments submitted by 5 P.M. CST, are processed the same day.

If you have been officially accepted into a University degree or certificate program, you may pay by installments. You must pay at least the minimum amount due by the due date. A \$35
fee for this service will be charged to your account once each semester.
