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Types of Rocks	1. <u>Linguistic</u> Design ROCK trading cards Choose 5 rocks of each of the 3 types of rocks. Name the rock, tell the type of rock, and describe the characteristics of the rock. Include a colored picture. Include extra fun facts to go beyond.	2. <u>Linguistic</u> Choose your favorite "rock" group: igneous, sedimentary, or metamorphic and design a CD cover! Be creative while illustrating your CD and while writing your song titles. Include the origin of the type of rock you chose, 3 examples of your type of rock, and 3 other important details about that specific type of rock. Include 2 colored pictures. Include song lyrics to make it special!	3. <u>Kinesthetic</u> Construct a floor plan or model of a house and identify the various locations that igneous, metamorphic and sedimentary rocks are found. Include a key that identifies the object or house feature, name of rock, and type of rock. Include 10-15 different rocks.

Include how the rock type has had an impact on economic production.	5. FREE SPACE Create your own idea! Your idea MUST be approved by me. Show you know how geologic history and past environmental conditions played a role in the bedrock of <b>Ohio</b> .	6. <u>Spatial</u> Research the various types of rocks found in Ohio. Create a geologic map of Ohio and label them according to their location. Determine what types of rocks are represented based on the environmental factors that lead to the various rocks formation.
Rock Cycle	7. <u>Spatial</u> Make a model showing how rocks change through the rock cycle. Be sure to use the 3 type of rocks in your display. Include colored pictures or drawings of each type of rock and cycle action.	8. <u>Intrapersonal</u> Write a narrative (story) from the point of view of a rock. Tell about the travels of the rock as it ventures through the rock cycle. (Maybe it ends up in the ocean, as part of a countertop or a piece of jewelry).
