## APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS – New Applicant/Not a Previous Recipient

This scholarship is for worthy young persons who are U.S. citizens and residents of Grant County, Oregon. The scholarship is awarded for undergraduate, trade or graduate school educational expenses up to a total of five years.

Recipients must:

- Complete a minimum of 12 credit hours per term/semester (full-time) or at least half-time status for part-time students.
- Achieve a 2.0 or better GPA in high school and the first year of post high school study.
- Achieve a 2.5 or better GPA in subsequent years of post-high school study.
- Submit a transcript (does not have to be official) following the end of each academic year.

- Failure to indicate the costs of tuition, room and board, and ALL GRANTS and SCHOLARSHIPS received for education purposes. This includes tuition offsets from the school that you are attending.
- Honesty about residency. If you do not qualify, explain why you do not qualify and rationale for requesting scholarship funds even though you may not qualify.

- ☐ CITIZENSHIP, RESIDENCY and SCHOOL HISTORY – Submit proof of U.S. citizenship (birth certificate, passport or naturalization documentation) and a history of where you have attended school since the 9<sup>th</sup> grade.
- ☐ STATEMENT OF GOALS – Submit a statement of your goals summarizing your reasons for your desire to continue your education and your tentative career goals. No more than one page.
